

## **CWMD** Signed into Law



"The CWMD Office will coordinate with other Federal efforts and develop a strategy and policy to plan for, detect, and protect against unauthorized chemical, biological, radiological, or nuclear materials or devices in the United States."

-President Trump, December 2018

In December 2018, President Trump signed into law the Countering Weapons of Mass Destruction Act of 2018, fully authorizing DHS CWMD.

CWMD leads DHS efforts against WMD terrorism and health security threats, and coordinates with domestic and international partners to safeguard against and respond to chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, and health security threats and incidents affecting the United States, its people, and its interests.


## Key 2020 Accomplishments
